高一資優英文版本文法綜合專論

1. Cleft Clause 分裂句

It is ...that...

(1) 強調句中主詞

e.g.

Grant is the one who looks exactly like Eddie Peng.

→ **It is Grant that looks exactly like Eddie Peng.**

(2) 強調句中受詞

e.g.

My mom enjoys watching a Taiwanese series every night.

→ **It is a Taiwanese series that my mom enjoys watching every night.**

(3) 強調句中修飾語副詞

e.g.

I saw him kiss the girl in the park.

→ **It was in the park that I saw him kiss the girl.**

e.g.

He used to go jogging in the park in the early morning.

→ **It was in the early morning that he used to jog on the park.**

2. No matter what / how / where / when / who..., S + V 無論...

e.g.

(1) No matter what he will do, I will support him.

(2) No matter who you are, you have to follow the rules.

(3) No matter when his friends need help, Mike always tries to help them.

1. 不論你走到哪裡，我都會跟著你。

2. 不論是誰嫁給 Grant，她都會是最幸福的女孩子。

3. 不論我做甚麼，我都是為了妳而做。

4. 我有五支手機，你喜歡哪一隻就帶回去吧！

5. 經理會挑選任何一位適合這個職位的人。

6. 你應該避免任何一件會傷害你健康的事情。

3. Non-restrictive relative clause (非限定用法的關係子句)

e.g.

(1) Since I watched Sex and the City, I have dreamed of a trip to New York City, which is known as the Big Apple.

(2) Rebecca has a husband who lives in Bangladesh.

c.f. Rebecca has a husband. who lives in Bangladesh.

1. Stella 借我一萬元，而那筆錢剛好夠我付房租。

2. 他們決定要在台灣第一高樓---台北 101 見面。

3 永遠支持他的父親在幾天前去世了。

4. 那男孩正走出大樓，是我的表弟。

5. 那個男人昨天中了樂透頭獎，捐錢給窮人。

6. 昨天被遺留在公車上的那本書，已經送到失物招領處了。

4. It seems that S + V → S seem(s) to + V

e. g.

(1) It seems that you don't need my help.

= You don't seem to need my help.

= You seem not to need my help. .

(2) It seemed that there was no one at home.

= There seemed to be no one at home.

(3) It seems that the old lady was famous before.

= The old lady seems to have been famous before.

(4) It seemed that I had left my cell phone behind at the restaurant.

= I seemed to have left my cell phone behind at the restaurant.
