The Names of the Eight Planets

八大行星的命名幾乎皆與羅馬神話有關喔！

Mercury : 因水星轉動快速，而以羅馬神話的商業與旅遊之神為名，相當於希臘神話中的信差之神 Hermes。

Venus : 金星是僅次太陽與月亮最亮的一顆星，因此古人便以羅馬神話中愛與美的女神命名。

Earth : 地球是唯一名字與神話不相關的星球，其名源自古英文與古日耳曼文。

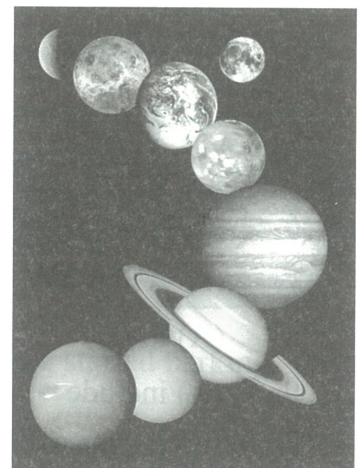
Mars : 火星又稱作 the Red Planet，因為外表呈紅色，讓人聯想到戰爭的血腥，因而以戰神 Mars 為名。
